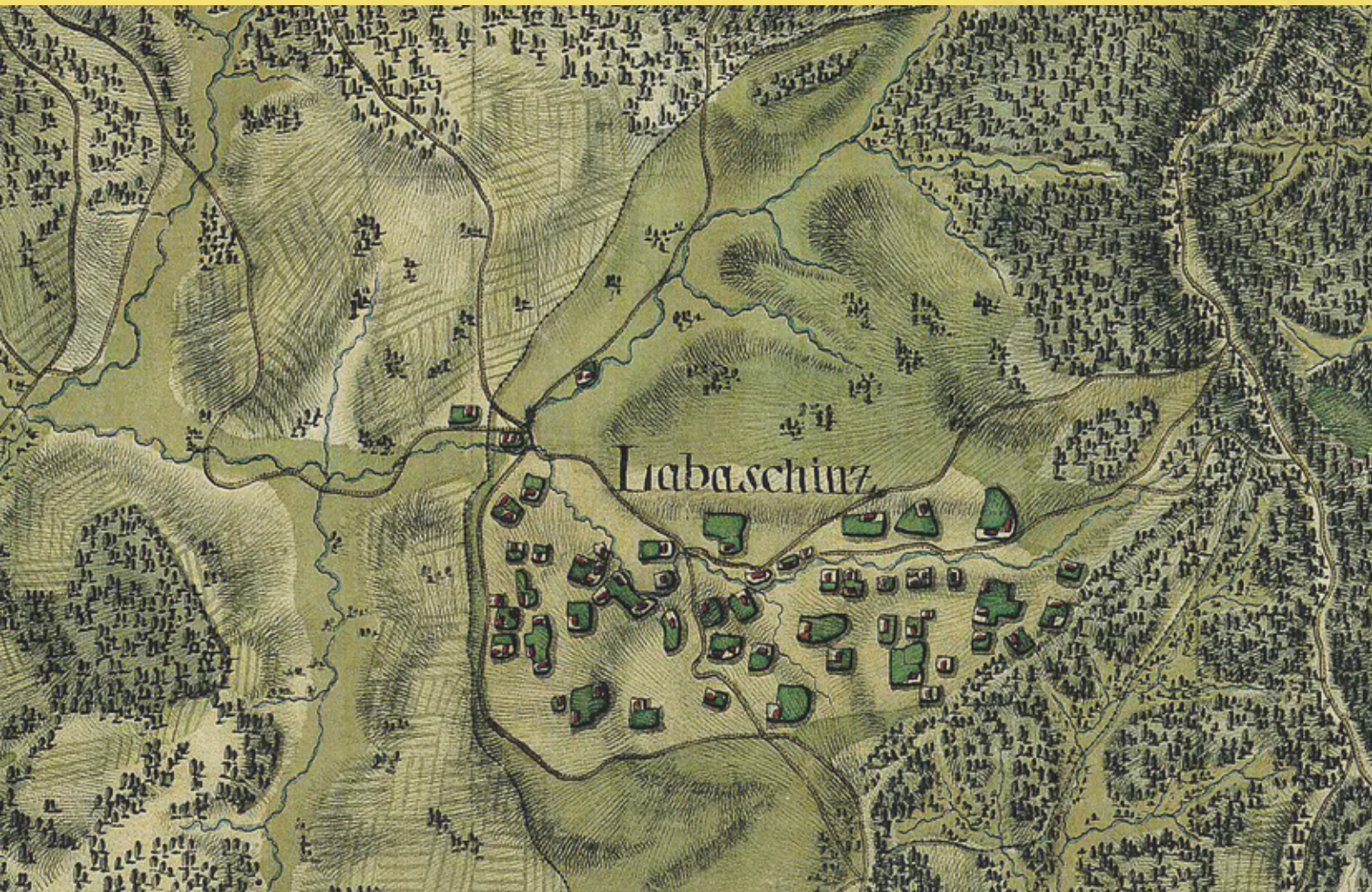
Once upon a time...

The first sign left by **Labasint** in the historical annals of these lands, is dated back to 1477 when for the first time the location is mentioned with the name of Labasowcz and was counted among the possessions of the Soimos castle that first belonged to the noble families of the Orszag, and later to the Bannfy ... After this, except for some sporadic appearances traced on ancient maps of kingdoms and empires that have taken place here, **Labasint** falls back into total oblivion again, as the Great History had forgotten this small valley hidden among the hills, protected by a forest dense of oaks and beeches...

But yet, sheltered from the great events that affected Transylvania during the course of the years, **Labășinț** continued to exist and to flourish so much that after a jump of over four centuries full of ups and downs, of famines and invasions, plagues and wars, the Socec yearbook, that was published in Bucharest in 1924, note that **Labășinț** is a thriving community of over 500 people, with a mayor, a notary and a teacher, two blacksmiths and a miller ... Then, still a world conflict, the last one, the new regime that followed the war, the collectivizations, the voluntary or forced migrations towards the big cities in need of manpower for the new big industries, managed to accomplish what the dark and tumultuous centuries of the past and two world wars: little by little and then faster and faster **Labășinț** began to depopulate until only three elderly families remained and nature gradually reconquered its spaces where the houses once raised ...

Today as Yesterday

One thing has remained unchanged through the passage of time and through the succession of the changing human events: **Labasint's Nature**, thriving and wild that welcomes tourists, today as yesterday, who enters the small valley that winds through the western Carpathian hills, in the heart of a natural area of over 34,000 hectares.

An area rich of luxuriant oaks and beeches woods, where the dusty country roads that crosses the green hills lined with grazing sheep and horses, cultivated fields and orchards, the rich wildlife of the forest, the numerous springs of pure water, today as yesterday represents the precious and intact treasure of this graceful valley.

It is in this natural environment that **Labasint's AgroVillage®** works, first of all representing the will to live and share with those who desire a life experience focused on the awareness of how important and fundamental the nature-health combination is, always keeping in our mind that the research of our wellness cannot be separated from the search of a good food and lifestyle balance.



A philosophy that moves around the person well-being, the desire to live and the environment that surrounds us, realized through the construction of a tourist and residential complex of the highest level, eco-compatible and energy self-sufficient, perfectly integrated into the unspoiled natural setting of the area.

A place studied to regenerate the psychophysical conditions of its inhabitants, who can choose to live here permanently, or only for a holiday period, a real bio-green life experience projected for the the national and international market.





The **AgroVillage®** project, currently being implemented, is developed by the holding company **Agro Sirena sa**, a Romanian public limited company which owns the entire real estate assets and holds licenses and operating authorizations.

The company is working in three different developing phases, the first two have already been completed and the third is under construction. Also the activity part has been thought in three different sections but complementary to each other: **tourism, real estate and production.**

PHASE 1 The Research – finished phase



The first phase of the project was the search of a location that had all the skill required for the creation of **AgroVillage®**: an uncontaminated natural area but included in a master plan that would allow its residential development, easily accessible and near to urban centers, communication routes and airports.

The large clearing of **Labasint**, with an area of about 1,000 hectares surrounded by forest, only a few traditional houses, the gentle hillside of western Transylvania with a mild climate compared to the other areas of the country, immediately proved to be the ideal location for the development of our project.





Although immersed in the unspoiled nature of the Carpathians, **Labasint** is nearby 5 important Romanian cities with a total population of over 1,000,000 people. Timisoara's international airport, less than an hour drive away, is connected with daily flights, including low-cost ones, to the capital Bucharest and the major Romanian cities, as well as to the most important European airports of Italy, France, Germany, Spain, Belgium, Holland and Great Britain.

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Part of the company's assets are also numerous restored buildings nearby the resort and destined to enhance the accommodation capacity.

In addition, some structures with a more purely technical destination have been used for 0 Km high-quality agro-food productions for consumption within the resort and also outside of it, involving labor and local producers.

PHASE 3 The Development – under construction



Once the land purchase phase got fixed, the construction of the first tourist houses and real estate structures began; the shipbuilding phase was completed within a few years, always in the strictest observance of those principles of respect for the places and the already existing surroundings, with particular attention not only to the desired aesthetic result but also to the protection of the ecological, historical and cultural point of views.

In fact, since the design phase, technical solutions have been adopted dimensionally and aesthetically fit and integrate harmoniously into the rural context of the locality, preserving where possible the existing and inserting the new in a respectful manner, also using as much as possible the of traditional materials such as old wooden beams, tiles and bricks. In choosing all the building materials and the technical solutions adopted, the utmost attention has always been paid to their eco-compatibility and energy saving.



During the construction phase of the first structures of the resort, **Agro Sirena s.a.** has started the bureaucratic procedures to obtain the necessary authorizations of the touristic and recreational activities of the resort. Agro Sirena s.a. owns all the authorizations and permissions required to operate, released by the competent administrative and control authorities, in full compliance with the Romanian and European norms.

The first tourist facilities, covering an area of over 44,000 square meters, began operating in 2016 under the brands **AgroVillage®** and **Labășinț Forest®**, at that time mainly working in the team building sector and organizing themed events. Among its customers several important multinational companies.



Suites Hotel and the restaurant



The four-star hotel, consisting in elegant and exclusive suites with hydromassage shower in each room, is equipped with everything needed to offer maximum comfort even in the middle of the forest.

AgroVillage® is complemented by other structures harmoniously inserted in a more than 4 hectares park area fenced and under video surveillance. For families and customers who want more privacy, the **Country House** and **Chalets** offer the possibility of a more intimate stay and exclusive facilities, cellar equipped with the best Romanian and foreign wines, tasting and outdoor dining area, barbecue and outdoor Jacuzzi.

The **Stala Dance** is the disco of the resort, created from the old horse stables. Equipped with an open bar and professional sound systems, it is also open to host external events.



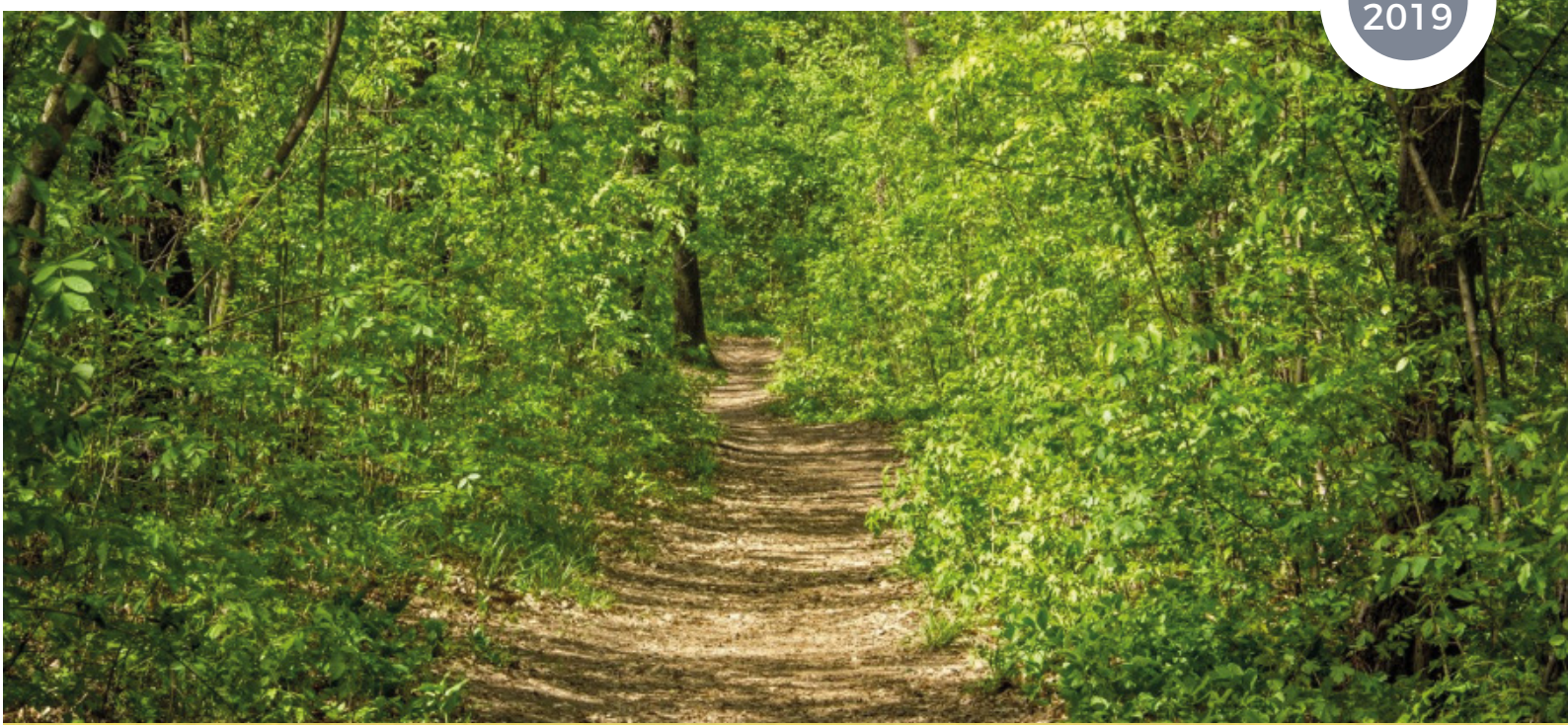
ATV & MTB

The landscape context of the area, with its numerous paths through the hills and in the forest, is particularly suitable for ATV and MTB excursions. On several occasions the **AgroVillage®** resort has hosted gatherings and events, including international ones, of these sports. The resort has a fleet of **Polaris** ATVs, available for people who like to take guided tours and also mountain bikes and pedal-assisted bicycling.





The mapping and restoration of a large part of the numerous existing paths has been completed, with the placement of specific marks on the paths and indication of length, difficulty and travel time infos, to allow you to fully enjoy the immense natural heritage that surrounds the resort, with organized excursions, Nordic walking or simple walks. In 2019 a life path to practice outdoor activities and yoga and shinrin yoku courses under the guidance of expert teachers will be ready.



The Activities



The **Free Area** has been designed to please the demand of a less exclusive and demanding tourism, even daily visitors are welcome, mainly made of young people and families. It is attached to the Resort, but outside of it, and thanks to its attractions, the **Free Area** is an independent activity and a real driving force for the more exclusive resort area, to which the guests of the Free Area will have access, after getting the special pass, to benefit also the higher level services.

In the Free Area, children have at their disposal a fenced playground next to the restaurant area and the pony horse area, where they can ride horses and walk under the guidance of the safe and qualified **AgroVillage®** staff.

In the Free Area there is also a rental point for mountain bikes and bicycles with assistance, as well as the starting point for guided ATV tours. The dining area consists in a covered area of about 300 square meters set up with tables and benches to be able to serve grills and hamburgers prepared in the field kitchen. For those who prefer to cook there are numerous grill stations available for the guests.

The Free Area also provides the opening of a minimarket that sells 0 km food and wine products produced in the **Labasint** area.



Glamping: face to face with Nature



Glamor Camping, or eco-friendly living based on the pure contact with nature but in comfort, is growing rapidly on international levels. Still under construction, **AgroVillage® Glamping** includes large-sized tents, placed on wooden platforms raised from the ground, fully set up and furnished with designer furniture.

Each tent is wide and offers all the comfort of a hotel room: beds, sheets, wardrobes, mirrors, as well as toilets with showers in every tent.

Glamping can be done in all seasons as many tents are equipped with a heating system. A chic, comfortable and eco-friendly campsite immersed in the naturalistic scenery of the valley, the most authentic and direct way to live the contact with nature.
